


General Cleaning Instructions

A soft cloth or wet sponge and approved household cleaners can be used for general cleaning.

Precautions:

Immediately remove any construction/installation materials, such as concrete, silicone, paint, labels, or tape.

Avoid abrasive cleaners (such as Ajax, Comet, rouge, cerium oxide).

Hydrofluoric and phosphoric acid are corrosive to the coating and glass surfaces and should not be used.

Do not use abrasive brushes, razor blades or other sharp objects which may scratch the coating or glass.
